My decision to dive into Dugg Burger was rewarded with a choice of unlimited burger toppings and a plethora of tasty seasoned french fries. Dugg Burger is not your average burger joint. The name stems from the fact that your bun is actually "dugged out" and filled with your choice of toppings. After placing your order, your burger is grilled while you choose your toppings. I really like how Dugg Burger doesn't nickel and dime you for extra toppings like many burger restaurants. I proudly stuffed my bun with sauteed mushrooms, lettuce, tomato, crispy onions, and bacon.

I was really impressed with my burger. I am a stickler for sweet hamburger buns and my bun did not disappoint. I was a little scared that I might have gone overboard on the toppings but they really complimented the burger. The only bad thing I have to say about Dugg Burger is that its too close to my house.
