After a long and tiring bike ride around White Rock lake, Dugg burger provides a tasty lunch you just can't compete with. All things considered, I know this is Whataburger country, but hear me out. Whataburger is great in its own way don't get me wrong, but we're talking simple burger to a much more flavorful one. Dugg seems to be the go to place for me whenever I'm near White Rock Lake. In other words, I might be obsessed.

So what makes a Dugg burger? For the most part, It's simple enough. You place your order with the cashier and move forward. The design is similar to subway, in which you decide what you want on your burger. There's the usual, ketchup, mustard, and mayo that some may want. I recommend you go with the spicy ranch. It seems to be the most popular and most flavorful of the sauces. Next comes the vegetables. Unlike my siblings, I'm not a picky eater so I go for the lettuce and grape tomatoes along with the raw onions. You do have an option of doing caramelized onions and/or crispy onion strings. Albeit, I've yet to try the crispy onion strings. For me, I add the sautéed mushrooms and fire-roasted jalapenos to the hickory-smoked bacon and call it a day.

What I hate most about burgers or hot dogs is the unnecessarily amount of bun. That's just carbs I don't need. So with this in mind Dugg carves out the inside of the top bun and place the vegetables within. My mouth is watering just writing about it. The burger is tasty, fresh, and spicy. The grilled jalapenos definitely add a kick to every bite. At the same time, the french fries are an excellent side dish. The fries are crunchy and packed with a modest amount of seasoning.

Not much else to say about this burger joint, other than it's a must have on the list of places to eat in Dallas. The food isn't fancy or overpriced, but it's worth every penny. The atmosphere is nice and friendly. You don't have to be at the lake in order to grab a bite unless you want to gain all the calories you just lost.
